Thank you for applying to be a mentor in the Computer Science department! To apply, please complete the attached application and email it to advisor@cs.fsu.edu.

Mentor Requirements and Responsibilities:

To be a mentor, you must:

- Be an undergraduate or graduate, main campus student in the Computer Science department
- Taking or passed COP 4530, Data Structures
- Have a 2.7 or higher GPA
- Be willing to devote the time to being a mentor

Once you complete the application, you will be contacted for an interview. If selected, you will be contacted with your mentee's name, phone number and email, so you may initiate contact. It is expected that you will contact your mentee within the first two weeks of receiving the contact information. We expect mentors to meet with their mentees outside of WiCS events at least once a month, but also maintain open communication with their mentee during other times in the semester. As a mentor, you should be a guide, resource, and support contact for your mentee.

Mentorships last for a semester, with an option to continue the mentorship in following semesters.

The application deadline for Spring 2018 mentorships is January 26.
