Wildcards

- Used to specify files that fit a pattern
- Used to specify multiple files

Valid Filename Characters

- Alphanumeric (A-Z, a-z, 0-9)
- Dot (.)
- Some others
- UNIX is case-sensitive

?	Matches a single character
*	Matches zero or more characters
[<set>]	Matches one of the characters in <set>

Sets

- A set can contain any series of characters to be matched
- A hyphen (-) may be used to specify a range of characters

[V1046r]	Matches one or more of the characters 'V', '1', '0', '4', '6', or 'r'
[A-Za-z]	Matches one or more upper or lowercase letters
[0-9a-d]	Matches one or more digits and the characters 'a', 'b', 'c', or 'd'

Examples

```
ls -l auto*
ls *.zip
rm catch?2
ls [fmt]ile[0-9]
rm * (Beware of using this command)
```

Example directory
