Bachelor of Arts: Humanities & Minor Requirements Computer Science, Computer Programming & Applications

The Bachelor of Arts requires nine (9) semester hours in the fields of humanities and history, in addition to the liberal studies and the foreign language requirements. Each of the majors above requires a minor. A student may choose to minor in one of the below areas and if so, the minor will fulfill the nine hours of history/humanities beyond the liberal studies.

Students in these majors may choose one of two options:

- 1. A humanities-area minor, which will satisfy the minor <u>and</u> 9-hour BA requirement simultaneously, OR
- 2. A minor outside of the areas listed below <u>plus</u> 9 hours of humanities/history coursework beyond liberal studies and the foreign language requirement.
